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You are entitled to a copy of any letter we write about you. Please ask if you want one when you come to the hospital.

If you are unhappy with the advice you have been given by your GP, consultant, or another healthcare professional, you may ask for a second (or further) opinion.

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## ***Vascular One-stop Clinic***

### **What is the one-stop vascular clinic?**

The one-stop vascular clinic saves you having to come to the hospital twice by linking two appointments into one.

You will first have an ultrasound scan, followed by an appointment with a doctor.

### **How long will I be at the hospital?**

Please allow two hours for this combined appointment. It is important that you attend both appointments.

### **What will happen at the clinic?**

You will first have a painless ultrasound scan. This is so that the doctor can understand what is happening with your blood vessels. You will then see the doctor who will explain the results of the scan and work out a plan for your care.

### **What do I need to bring with me?**

Please bring a list of any medication that you are taking, including any over the counter or alternative/herbal remedies.
