

Recycling unwanted crutches, sticks and frames



As a Trust we now recycle returned metal crutches (in a pair held together with an elastic band), sticks and frames which can still be used. If you have been loaned any of the above, no longer need them and would like to return them, please do so to any of the places below:

- Emergency Department, Main Hospital, Level 3
- Physiotherapy Department, Main Hospital, Level 3
- The Recycling Centre based in the Old Fovant ward, SDH South.

If you have equipment other than metal sticks, crutches or frames, which you no longer need, please check the equipment for any labels on where to return it and contact them directly.

By returning this equipment when you no longer need it, you are helping the Trust to save money, as we are able to recycle it. If there is equipment which is returned to us which we are unable to recycle, it will be sent abroad to Africa to help provide vital equipment and support.
