The Department of Sexual Health offers advice and treatment for all aspects of sexual health and contraception, regardless of age, disability, ethnicity, religion, whether you are male, female, transgender, straight, gay or bisexual.

Open access

No referral is needed to access our service. Just call 01722 425120 to make an appointment or turn up to one of our walk in clinics.

Here to listen, not to tell

We provide a confidential service to all our patients, including those under 16. In exceptional circumstances, if you or someone else is at risk of serious harm, we may have to refer to other agencies, but not without your knowledge.

Free treatments

If you are entitled to NHS treatment, no payment is required for accessing the service or for any treatment or contraception provided.

Fast reliable results

Results are available up to two weeks after testing. You can decide if you receive your results via text to your mobile, or return to clinic.

Experienced practitioners

Our staff are experienced and dedicated sexual health and contraception clinicians able to discuss with you your options and treatments. You will be able to make informed decisions regarding all aspects of your care.

What we offer at our clinics

- Emergency contraception
- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
- Combined pill, patch and ring
- Progestogen only contraceptive pills
- Depo-Provera (Depo Injection) & Sayana Press
- Implants
- Intra-uterine devices/systems (coils)
- Diaphragms
- Condoms – male and female
- Pregnancy Testing
- Hepatitis B vaccination
- HIV care and management
- HIV point-of-care testing
- HIV post exposure prophylaxis
