- Early mobilisation and discharge











#### **New Services: One Year On**

#### Day-case Arthroscopic ACL Reconstruction



- 55 Patients
- Arthroscopic technique
- Hamstring tendon autograft
- 80% same day discharge
- No re-ruptures



#### **Partial Knee Replacement**







- 34 Patients
- Average LOS 1.8 days
- 0 transfusions0 reoperations
- 13 point rise in mean OKS

### **Enhanced Recovery post Total Knee Replacement**



- 40 Patients
- Average LOS
   2.8 days
- 0 transfusions
- 0 reoperations

Time to Shine

#### **Joint Preserving Osteotomies**



- 13 Patients
- · LOS 1.7 days
- 0 transfusions
  - 18 point rise in mean OKS at 3 months
- No complications
