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


2010

- A new approach since 2010 to enable earlier recovery after surgery
- A fully structured and well organised sequence of clinical care.
- Requiring planning and pre-operative assessment
- Changes to anaesthetics and surgical techniques
- Early mobilisation and discharge

New Services: One Year On

Day-case Arthroscopic ACL Reconstruction



- 55 Patients
- Arthroscopic technique
- Hamstring tendon autograft
- 80% same day discharge
- No re-ruptures



Partial Knee Replacement



- 34 Patients
- Average LOS 1.8 days
- 0 transfusions
- 0 reoperations
- 13 point rise in mean OKS




Enhanced Recovery post Total Knee Replacement



- 40 Patients
- Average LOS 2.8 days
- 0 transfusions
- 0 reoperations

Joint Preserving Osteotomies



- 13 Patients
- LOS 1.7 days
- 0 transfusions
- 18 point rise in mean OKS at 3 months
- No complications
