

## Price List

Understanding your treatment costs can help you plan for your fertility treatment. Please note that all treatment cycles are individual and may not follow this plan exactly, therefore this should be used as a guide only. Detailed costed treatment plans will be provided at your initial appointment.

**Please note that patients are asked to make payment prior to the start of each treatment cycle; no procedures or investigations will be carried out if invoices are outstanding. Cancellations made more than 48 hours before the appointment will receive a full refund. Cancellations made within 48 hours, where the appointment is not rescheduled, are non-refundable.**

## Stage 1 - Pre-Treatment

### Initial Medical Consultation

- An appointment with one of our consultants/fertility specialists to discuss your fertility history, the results of any investigations you've had already and recommendations for further investigation or treatments. The initial consultation includes a trans-vaginal ultrasound scan. £220

### Follow-up or subsequent Consultation

- An additional follow up appointment with the consultant/fertility specialist is for patients to discuss results of further investigations or treatments. £145
- If you have had previous treatment with us, a follow up appointment will be required prior to planning further treatment.

### Fertility Assessments

  - Hysterosalpingo Contrast Sonography procedure

- Hysterosalpingo Contrast Sonography (HyCoSy) £450
  - A procedure used to investigate the cavity of the uterus and fallopian tubes to see if an egg can travel down them with ease. This is only for patients already registered at Salisbury Fertility Centre.

- SIS £350
  - A Saline Infusion sonohysterogram, used to investigate the cavity of the uterus.

- **Surgical Sperm Retrieval (SSR)** £2,400
  - For patients who are not producing sperm in their semen, a surgical sperm retrieval may be recommended. This includes onsite sperm retrieval (TESE/mTESE), virology screening (HIV, Hep B, Hep C), SSR sperm freezing and storage for 1 year. Please note there is no refund if sperm cannot be successfully procured from this procedure.
  - Patients returning for further treatment need repeat semen analysis if not done in last 12 months, which is chargeable and additional to treatment

## Stage 2 - Treatments

**Patients must have an initial medical consultation, with relevant fertility check if necessary, prior to the treatments below.**

**Please note that if pre-treatment screening tests have been completed and you choose not to continue with treatment, a screening test charge is applicable - £420 for the female patient and £305 for the partner.**

## IVF Packages

In-Vitro Fertilisation (IVF) refers to assisted conception which takes place outside the body. During this process, eggs are removed from the ovaries and fertilised with sperm in the laboratory. The patient will undergo hormone stimulation so that several eggs are obtained. The fertilised egg is cultured to a blastocyst stage embryo and transferred into the womb. Good quality spare embryos may be frozen to enable transfer at a later date.

## Frozen Embryo Transfer (FET)

This refers to the process where a frozen embryo from a previous IVF or ICSI cycle is thawed and placed into the womb.

## Intra-uterine Insemination

Intra-uterine Insemination (IUI) is where the patient has assisted conception by the placement of specially prepared sperm into the womb at the time when eggs are being released. This can be performed when the patient releases eggs naturally, and is called a natural cycle, or the patient can be stimulated to release an egg

using fertility drugs, called a stimulated cycle. The sperm used can be from your partner. For patients using sperm from a donor, this is known as donor insemination (DI). Patients using donor sperm can choose the donor from information given by the donor bank – the banks used by Salisbury Fertility Centre are European Sperm Bank, London Sperm Bank and SEMOVO.

A non-invasive treatment to induce ovulation via medication.

## Egg Freezing

Egg freezing provides the option for you to start a family when you are ready. Patient may choose to freeze their eggs if they are postponing a family for social reasons, considering other treatment which may cause loss of fertility, are at increased risk of early menopause, or are considering gender reassignment.

## Egg Thawing

When you are ready to use your frozen eggs in an IVF treatment cycle, you will need to see the consultant to review your medical circumstances and discuss an egg thawing treatment cycle. A routine trans-vaginal ultrasound scan is required - this scan and the follow-up consultation are included in the costs already paid. If you are using your partner's sperm, a semen analysis is needed. The ICSI procedure is required when using frozen eggs.

## Egg Sharing & IVF

IVF with egg sharing is where the female patient goes through an IVF cycle and donates half of her collected eggs to another couple. The recipient couple need donated eggs because the female partner has poor ovarian function

due to disease, surgery, premature menopause or age. There could also be genetic reasons why she cannot use her own eggs. For the egg share cycle to proceed, eight or more eggs must be collected, allowing a minimum of four eggs for the patient and four for the recipient. Provided you meet the eligibility criteria, egg sharing may be suitable for you if you are looking to reduce the cost of your IVF treatment and consent to donate some of your eggs to another couple. In an egg sharing treatment cycle the egg share provider pays a treatment cost and deposit, the cost of their drugs and the HFEA licence fee. If the egg share cycle proceeds and there are at least four eggs each available for the provider and recipient following the egg collection, then the deposit is returned to the egg share provider. If you are interested in being an egg sharer, please contact The Fertility Centre to assess whether you meet our eligibility criteria.

*If sufficient eggs are collected and the provider chooses to withdraw consent for the egg share (before embryo transfer) – the provider will be required to pay a full IVF package price (the £1000 deposit and £700 egg share cycle fee will be used towards this cost), plus the cost of any additional screening tests that were required for egg sharing.*

*Failed fertilisation - £1000 deposit refunded.*

*If the egg share goes ahead as planned, the provider will receive their £1000 deposit back once quarantine release screening is completed.*

## Egg Recipient

This involves using eggs in your treatment which have been donated by other patients, and you will receive a minimum of 4 eggs. If you are an egg recipient, this may include treatment with eggs donated by an altruistic

donor whose eggs are shared with up to two anonymous recipients, or with eggs from a patient who has had IVF treatment themselves and who donates half their eggs to an anonymous recipient. Once you have accepted the match with the donor this is your commitment to proceed with treatment, financial implications are detailed below.

## Embryo Recipients

This involves using embryos in your treatment which have been donated by other patients. If you are an embryo recipient, this includes treatment with embryos donated from other patients who wish provide others with the chance of conceiving, and you will receive a minimum of two embryos. Once you have decided on the set of embryos you wish to have, this is a commitment to proceed with treatment.

There could also be genetic reasons why she cannot use her own eggs. If you are interested in being an altruistic egg donor, please contact The Fertility Centre to assess whether you meet our eligibility criteria.

## Sperm Freezing

You may wish to freeze and store sperm for many different reasons. You may wish to have a ‘back up freeze’ if there is a low sperm count and wish to store a sample ahead of treatment. You may also wish to freeze sperm if you are having medical treatment which may put your fertility at risk, store before a vasectomy, military deployment, or gender reassignment. If you believe you will need a surrogate to use your stored sperm in the future, please let us know before your storage appointment.

## Surrogacy

If you need a surrogate and have located a suitable surrogacy gestational carrier for your fertility journey, we can aid with our assisted conception services. There are various stages of the treatment cycle and you will be provided with detailed information about the costs associated with them. Please note that all treatment cycles are individual. Please contact Salisbury Fertility Centre if you would like to discuss this in more detail.

### Treatment Extras

- Assisted Hatching £300
  - This involves the use of lasers or micropipettes to thin or make a small hole in the zona pellucida, which is thought to help the embryo to hatch. Assisted hatching is not used routinely at Salisbury Fertility Centre but is offered in very select cases. There is only limited evidence to support the idea that assisted hatching is of benefit, especially in a first cycle of treatment.
- EmbryoGlue® £400
  - EmbryoGlue® is a product designed to mimic the conditions found within the uterus at the time of embryo implantation. It intends to increase the chance of implantation, however there is no conclusive evidence for or against its use and in fact results are conflicting. However, we respect patient choice and can provide EmbryoGlue® at your request.
- Endometrial Scratch £300
  - Studies have suggested that this technique may facilitate the process of implantation by increasing the secretion of these growth factors in women who have had previous failed attempts at IVF. At Salisbury Fertility Centre, we do not routinely offer this procedure to new patients. Only very small subsets of patients, who have had successful outcomes in previous cycles using an endometrial scratch test, are offered this procedure.

### Storage

One year of storage is included in treatments including sperm freezing, egg freezing, and embryo freezing where culturing has been successful. Additional years and further pricing are detailed below.

- Sperm, Egg and Embryo storage per additional year £350
- 5 years sperm storage £1,400
- 10 years sperm storage £2,550

### Gamete / Embryo Transport

For patients who wish to transport their samples stored at Salisbury Fertility Centre to another Centre for treatment, the following fees apply:

- Co-ordination fee for movement of gametes and embryos within the UK out of the centre £300  
(Courier will charge fee additional)

- No co-ordination fee for movement of gametes and embryos in to the Centre from within the UK (there may be costs from courier and the exporting clinic)
- Co-ordination fee for movement of gametes and embryos outside of the UK (Courier fee will be additional) £500
- Co-ordination fee for movement of gametes and embryos in to the Centre from outside the UK £250
