

HELP WITH PARKING COSTS

If you are receiving one of the following you may qualify for Discounted Parking/Season Ticket:

- Patients receiving Universal Credit.
- Patients receiving Disabled Person's Tax Credit.
- Patients who are holders of HC2 or HC3 Certificate from NHS Low Income Scheme.
- Patient is a child, and parents are in receipt of one of the above allowances.
- Income Support.
- Guaranteed Pension Credit.
- NHS Tax Credit including Child Tax Credit.
- War Pensions if treating a war injury.
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance.
- ESA income-based.
- Any two or more appointments in one week.

Visitors may apply for a Discounted Season Ticket if they are:

- Visitors of long-stay or critically ill patients.
- Visitors of an 'out of area' patient and are staying locally or on site to enable repeat visits.
- As a visitor, play an active role in the recuperation / rehabilitation of a patient prior to and post discharge.
- At the special request of Sister/Charge Nurse of the relevant ward.

Patients or visitors applying for Season Tickets need to complete a "Patients' Parking Season Ticket Request Form". These forms are available from Out-Patient Clinics; Wards and Customer Care.

Free Parking



Salisbury District Hospital offers free parking for Oncology and Haematology appointments.

To claim your free parking, please enter your registration into the parking tablet displayed at the Pembroke Suite Reception desk.

FREE PARKING IS AVAILABLE TO:

- Oncology/Haematology patients attending an Oncology/Haematology appointment with a clinician
- Patients attending for blood tests prior to appointment with Oncology/Haematology Clinician
- Patients attending for Treatment on Pembroke Suite
- Patients attending for Collection of Oral Chemotherapy
- Patients attending Pembroke Suite for review by the Acute Oncology Service

EXCLUSIONS INCLUDE:

- Relatives visiting an inpatient
- Parking for the duration of an inpatient stay
- Procedure on Nunton Day Assessment Unit
- Investigations in other departments

Please discuss parking options with the relevant ward if the exclusions listed above apply.

You may be asked to provide evidence of your entitlement to free parking on arrival at the Trust.

PARKING ALTERNATIVES

- **Frequent outpatient attenders** - Parking will be provided free to all outpatients who attend hospital for an appointment at least three times within a month and for an overall period of at least three months. A 'month' is defined as a period of 30 days. Please request a Frequent Outpatient Appointment Request Form from the attending department.
- **Season Tickets**—Patients or visitors applying for Season Tickets need to complete a "Patients' Parking Season Ticket Request Form". This form can be obtained from the Out-Patient Clinics; Wards; Customer Care; and Facilities Directorate.

BLUE BADGE PARKING

Blue Badges require validation to enable free parking on the Salisbury Hospital Site.

You can either take your badge to a location that has a Blue Badge Validation device (see map on the pop up banners or in the car parks or visit the Enquiries desk in Main Reception) or you can register on the APCOA Blue Badge portal (requires you to set up an account with APCOA) - <https://bluebadge.apcoa.co.uk>

If you do not validate your Blue Badge, You will be need to pay for your parking at one of the car park payment machines or via the app or enter you registration in Pembroke Suite (if applicable).

If you do not pay for your parking or register/validate your Blue Badge, you will receive a parking charge notice.
