## Items for escalation to Board

Items for escalation from the February 2019 Clinical Governance Committee:

- 1) NHS Seven Day Services Board Assurance Framework shows SFT has met the 4 priority standards for patients admitted as an emergency 7 days a week. The Committee was assured by the mitigation in place associated with the risk to the Endoscopy service and Interventional Radiology provision in relation to the 7 day service standards. SFT has also met the 4 priority standards for stroke and STEMI heart attack patients, except for stroke patients who need a daily consultant review at a weekend. The Deputy Medical Director is working with the stroke service clinical lead to consider alternative workforce options to meet the new hyperacute stroke standards.
- 2) Gastroenterology service review and short term, medium term and service sustainability plans the Committee were assured by the current mitigation in place, whilst recognising this is a longer term piece of work. The Chief Operating Officer was asked to provide:
  - 1) a report setting out the issues and actions completed so far with a plan going forward at the CGC meeting in March 2019.
  - 2) Strategic paper to the Board in May 2019.
  - 3) Assurance report on the Endoscopy contract at the CGC in July 2019
- 3) Positive assurance SFT has achieved excellent results in the national maternity survey 2018. Areas where scores had improved reflected the targeted work undertaken.

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
