<b>Items for escalation to Board</b>
<p>Items for escalation from the February 2019 Clinical Governance Committee:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) NHS Seven Day Services Board Assurance Framework – shows SFT has met the 4 priority standards for patients admitted as an emergency 7 days a week. The Committee was assured by the mitigation in place associated with the risk to the Endoscopy service and Interventional Radiology provision in relation to the 7 day service standards. SFT has also met the 4 priority standards for stroke and STEMI heart attack patients, except for stroke patients who need a daily consultant review at a weekend. The Deputy Medical Director is working with the stroke service clinical lead to consider alternative workforce options to meet the new hyperacute stroke standards.</li> <li>2) Gastroenterology service review and short term, medium term and service sustainability plans – the Committee were assured by the current mitigation in place, whilst recognising this is a longer term piece of work. The Chief Operating Officer was asked to provide:       <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) a report setting out the issues and actions completed so far with a plan going forward at the CGC meeting in March 2019.</li> <li>2) Strategic paper to the Board in May 2019.</li> <li>3) Assurance report on the Endoscopy contract at the CGC in July 2019</li> </ol> </li> <li>3) Positive assurance – SFT has achieved excellent results in the national maternity survey 2018. Areas where scores had improved reflected the targeted work undertaken.</li> </ol>
